





Sky Dishes & TV Aerials

You no longer need our permission to put up a TV aerial or satellite dish. However, you **must** keep to the conditions listed below:

-  If you put up an aerial or satellite dish you must make sure you fit it securely and professionally so it doesn't damage our property or create a risk or danger to anyone. (For example, it must be at least 2 metres off the ground). You must make sure that any damage to our property or your neighbours is repaired at your own cost.
-  The equipment **must not** be installed on the front of the house facing the road or main pavement. It can only be fitted at the rear of the property or on the gable end.
-  If we have to do repairs or incur costs because of what you have done then we will **charge you** for our costs in putting it right. This applies whether you are still living there or when your tenancy ends.
-  You are responsible for getting Planning Permission or any Building Warrant approval (from Dumfries & Galloway Council Planning Department) and for meeting all costs. This includes removal and reinstatement if we decide this is needed at the end of your tenancy.
